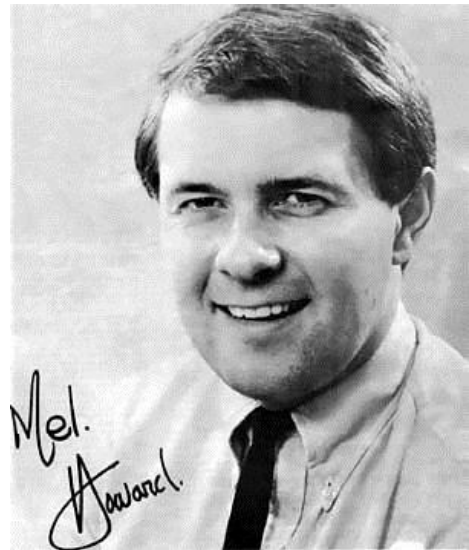

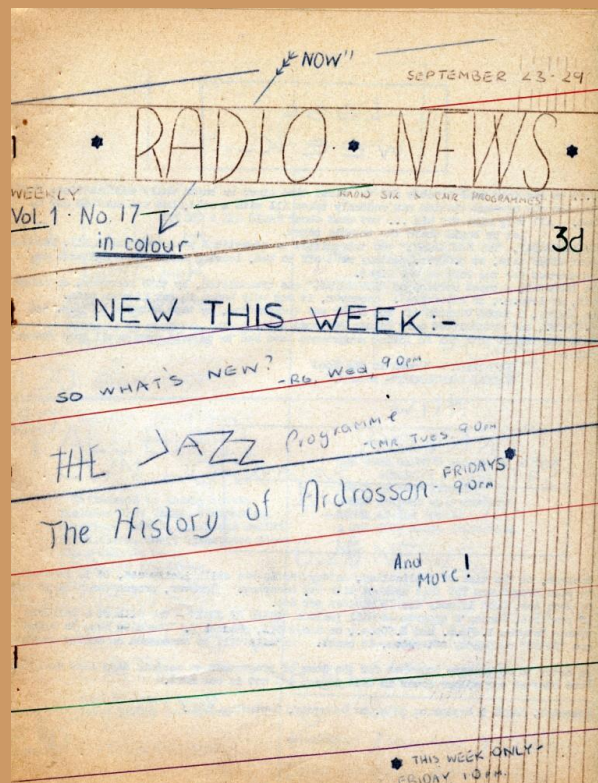

Our autumn schedule began in September 1967, with a slew of new series including "The Jazz Programme", "The Tony Currie Gogo Show" and the first regular lunchtime programme "Lunch Break". But it wasn't all music: "TRS Miscellany", was a topical magazine programme presented by *Charles Standon* from the tapes for the blind service; *Robert Allan's* "History of Ardrossan" tracked the story of our home burgh and "Storytime" presented short stories written by *Antony Walker*. The BBC's *Radio Times* introduced colour as a regular part of the magazine - and so, of course, did *Radio News!!*

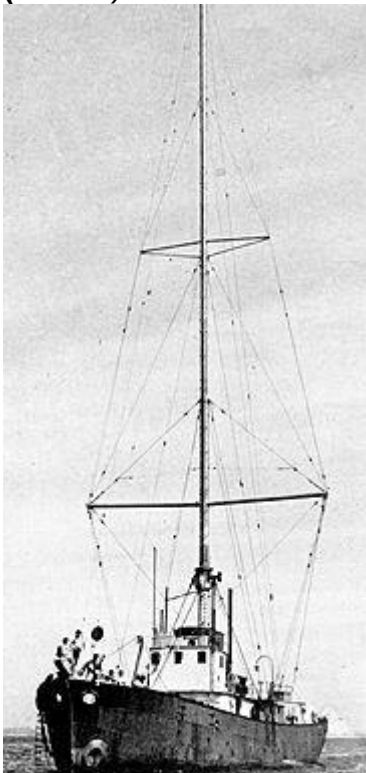

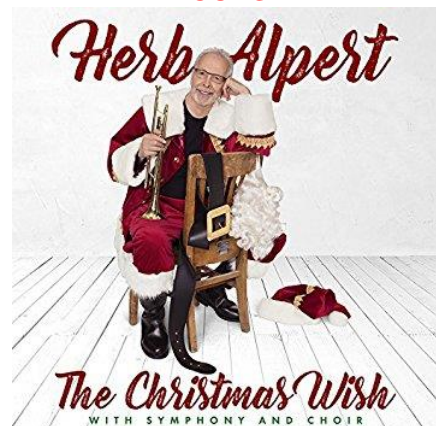
