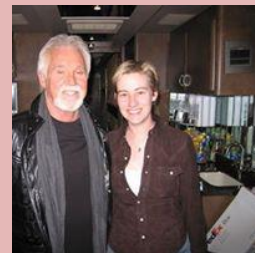

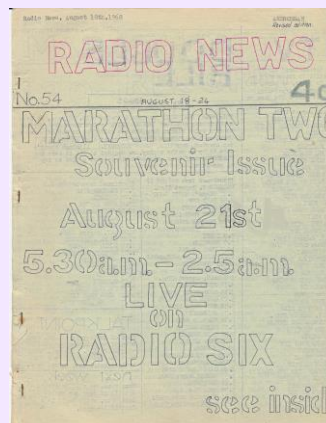

50 YEARS AGO



Half a century ago, Radio Six was ramping up for its second 'Marathon' broadcast. It had all started on Christmas Day 1967, when the station broadcast for 15 and a half hours non-stop and the team decided to attempt ever longer periods on air. In January they'd set a record of just over 19 hours, but in August 1968 the aim was over 20 and a half hours, starting at 5.25am and ending at 2.08am the following morning.

The day - Wed Aug 21st - dawned and the news broke that the USSR had invaded Czechoslovakia. The news team leapt into action and seventeen news bulletins were broadcast across the day as well as a half hour discussion of the situation in that day's scheduled edition of "Talkpoint".

Providing news and music programmes across the schedule were Tony Currie (both as himself and under the pseudonym 'Ronan'), Gordon Macdonald, Chris Seabury, Eric Macdonald and Robert Allan.

And with ITV on strike, Radio News also (unusually) carried the revised TV schedules for the ITV Network for the first weeks of the month!

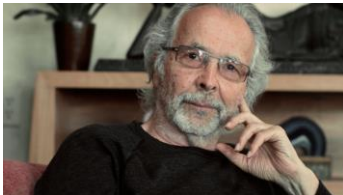
