Programme details printed in RADIO NEWS are correct at the time of printing, but last minute programme changes are always possible for either editorial or technical reasons. Our online programme schedule at radiosix.com will always reflect the latest schedule whenever possible. Although Radio Six International does not carry regular news bulletins, programmes can occasionally be interrupted for reports of major international news events.

November 1968 and just a few days after the Autumn programmes were launched, most of the station's (unpaid schoolboy) staff formed a union - The National Union of Disc Jockeys (NUDJ) and promptly went on strike after claiming that there were too many dangerous wires in the studio! Programmes continued with *Tony Currie* and *Chris Seabury* hosting most shows, *Chris* taking over the Top 30 from *Eric Macdonald*. *Chris* was about to launch his own station - Radio Stanleybank - in his own home a few hundred yards along the Crescent on the Ardrossan/Saltcoats border. But Radio News reported that the planned December 1st launch had been delayed because a breakdown at Radio Six meant that we were using *Chris's* tape recorder and he couldn't launch until he got it back!!

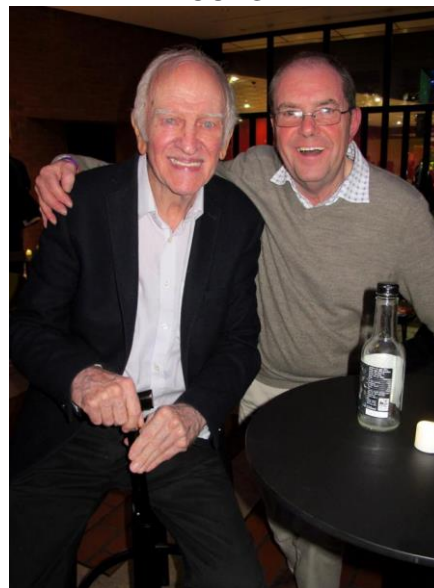
