## 50 YEARS AGO



1969 kicked off with a merger of the "Radio Stanleybank" magazine with "Radio News" and after a fortnight Radio Stanleybank was never mentioned again, as *Chris Seabury* had given it up!

Meanwhile a combination of exams and the acquisition of a colour television meant that station boss *Tony Currie* had his attention distracted resulting in a lot of days when only one half hour programme popped up on Radio Six. Plans were made to beef the output up from February but listeners had to make do with a rather dreary schedule in one of the dreariest months of the year! The only bright spot was that more programmes were appearing in stereo than had been regularly scheduled in 1968.

Most of the programming relied on playing LPs or Eps through (this was a hangover from the 1966 programme 'Longspin') but *Gordon Macdonald* brightened things up by taking over at the helm of the weekly Scottish music show 'Tarry Awhile', but a one-off revival of 'The A in Mac' (a battle of the turntables between Tony and Gordon) was postponed until February.
