50 YEARS AGO



March was a busy month for Radio Six, culminating in the Eurovision Song Contest from the Teatro Royal in Madrid, where sometime unprecedented happened - four songs tied for first place and all four were declared winners. Lulu took a trophy for the UK with "Boom Bang-a-Bang" (a song she really doesn't like!) composed by Alan Moorhouse and Peter Warne. For Spain, Salomé took a trophy for "Vivo Cantando", foe the Netherlands, Lenny Kuhr won with "De Troubadour" and France's Frida Boccara was also first equal with "Un Jour, Un Enfant".

Former US President Dwight D. Eisenhower died, and Radio Six broadcast a special tribute to him penned by Robert Allen. Unusually, we also took commentary of the Grand National from the BBC, although history does not explain exactly why!

Regular shows included "Tony Tonight" (no prizes for guessing whose show that was), a new stereo showcase titled "Impact!", Gordon Macdonald's weekly chat programme "Ad Lib", and the debut of a show which was to continue on the station for several decades - "Saturday Sounds" hosted by Tony Currie.

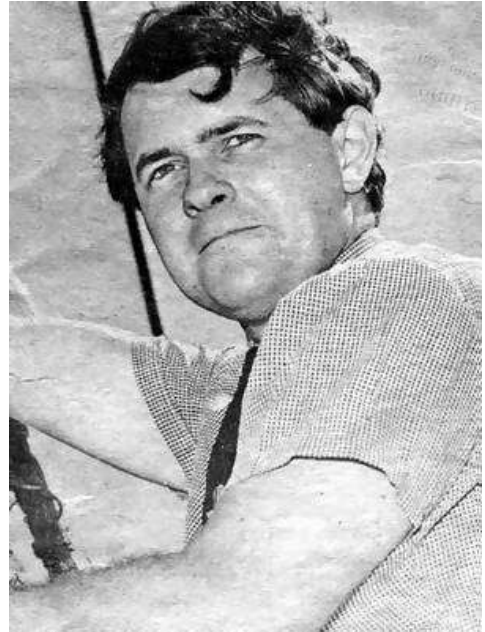
