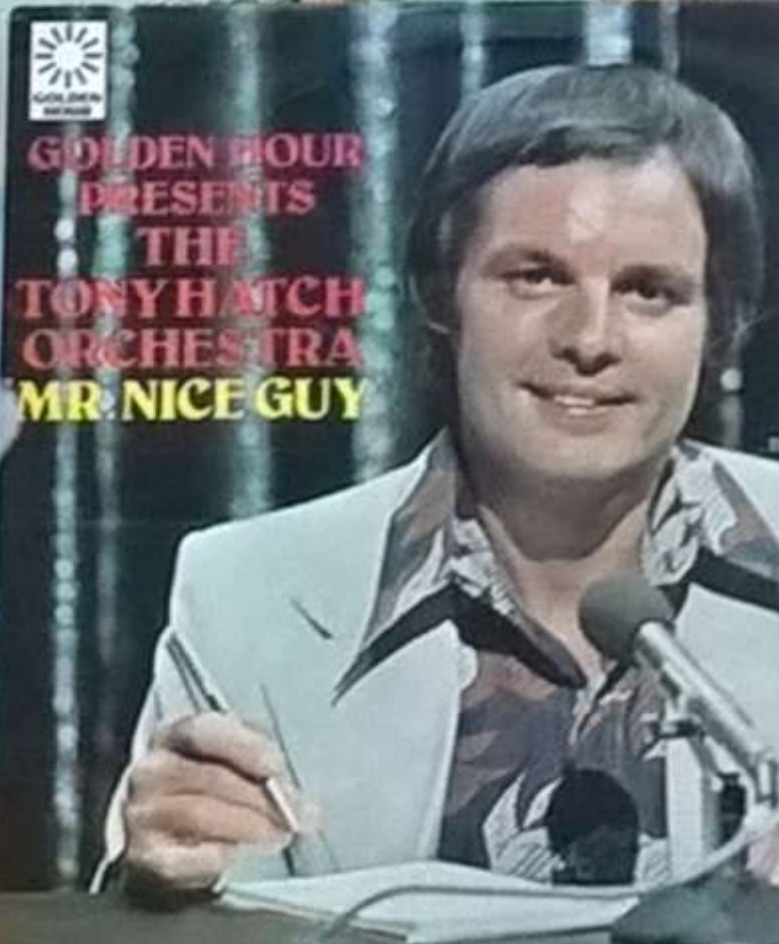

50 YEARS AGO



"After our anniversary programme on June 6th, we will cease daily broadcasting." *Tony Currie's* announcement on page three must have come as a bolt from the blue for listeners, but as the lad was leaving school, it seemed appropriate to put away the plaything of childhood. Indeed for a while it seemed that Radio Six might be ending for good, as the Ardrossan studio was dismantled and put away in boxes in a large cupboard. On the 'final' day, programmes started at 8am with "Bim! Bam!! Boom!!!" and carried on to end with "The Birthday Party" at 7pm (Guests *Elise Millar*, *Gordon Macdonald*, *Chris Seabury* and *Jean Wright* joined *Tony* in a recorded programme) followed by "Six of Six" celebrating the sixth anniversary of the station, and at five past midnight "News Headlines, Close-Down, End of Daily Transmissions".
Was it the end?
I think we know the answer to that one...
