

COVID-19

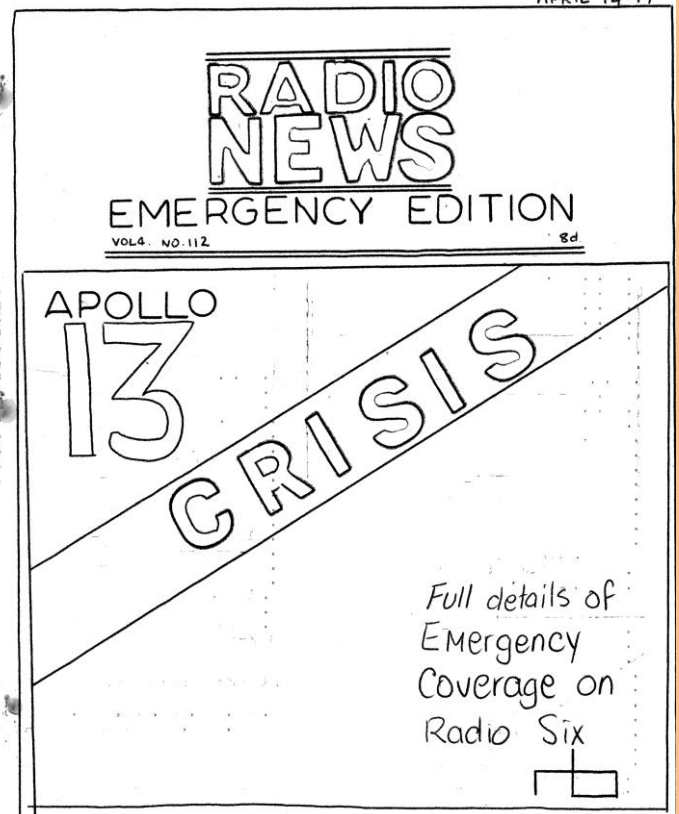

50 YEARS AGO



Fifty years ago we were reacting to a very different crisis from today's. **Apollo 13** was the seventh crewed mission in the Apollo space program and the third meant to land on the Moon. The craft was launched from Kennedy Space Centre on April 11, 1970, but the lunar landing was aborted after an oxygen tank in the service module failed two days into the mission. The crew instead looped around the Moon, and returned safely to Earth on April 17. The astronauts' peril briefly renewed interest in the Apollo program; tens of millions watched the splashdown in the South Pacific Ocean by television. The story of Apollo 13 has been dramatized several times, most notably in the 1995 film *Apollo 13*.

The Currie family had been on holiday in the Scottish Highlands when Apollo 13 was launched, and the station was not due to resume Ardrossan programming until April 15th. However, Radio Six went on air at 10.30pm on Tuesday, April 14th with a mixture of regular programmes and special reports under the dramatic title "Moon Mission Three - Crisis". Coverage continued each day until the safe return of the astronauts on Friday 17th.
