FM and SHORTWAVE TRANSMITTERS**

Some of our programmes are broadcast simultaneously from these FM transmitters: **Tawa 88.2MHz FM Stereo**, **Marahau 88.2MHz FM Stereo**, **Stoke 107.6MHz FM Stereo**, and **Taipei 95.5MHz FM Stereo**. Programmes on Tawa, Marahau & Stoke (New Zealand) are marked*, programmes on Taipei (Taiwan) marked ^. We also use shortwave from time to time, broadcasting on **6,070kHz (49.39 meters)** with a power of 10kW from a transmitter at Rohrbach in Germany. These programmes are marked + Many of our programmes are also rebroadcast at different times and days on AM, FM, and online by our network of affiliate stations around the world.

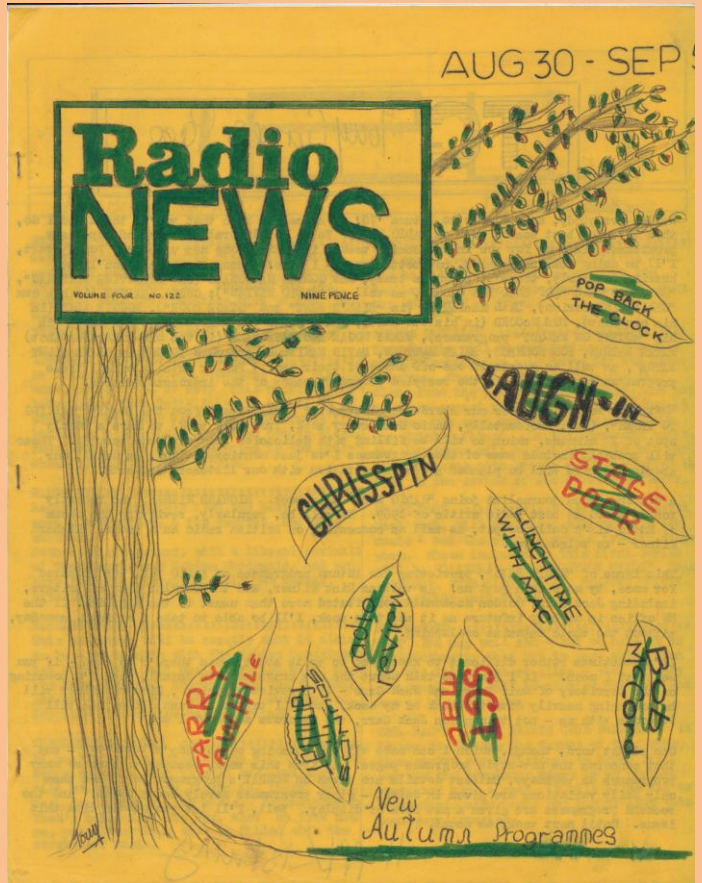

50 YEARS AGO



An 18 page issue heralded the start of an immensely exciting autumn for Radio Six. Most of the old favourites returned for new series - "Tarry Awhile", "Sgt Mac", "Chrisspin" and "Pop Back The Clock" were joined by new series, "Lunchtime with Mac", "Stage Door" and the mysterious Bob McCord (a pseudonym for Robert Allan!). The daily pattern was stable - opening up at 11.15am with "Morning Music" then Sam Costa from Radio 2, Mac in the middle and an hour of local programmes from 2pm until Dave Cash took over at 3, again from radio 2. Local programmes resumed at 5 with "Teatime with Tony" at 5.30 and the station signed off between 7.5pm and 10, returning for Radio 2's "Late Night Extra" at 10 with a local offering halfway through and closedown at 11.30. An ambitious schedule - remember this was still in Tony Currie's attic and as he wasn't working Radio Six was (as indeed it is again) his full time occupation. Issue 123 reported that there were plans to test the use of a very low power medium wave transmission to radiate programmes throughout Tony's Ardrossan home. These tests began on September 10th and issue 124 revealed that regular transmissions would start on October 25th with weekday test transmissions including one or two scheduled programmes as well as music. Exciting things were to come in October, including a change of Editor for "Radio News". -JACK CARR
