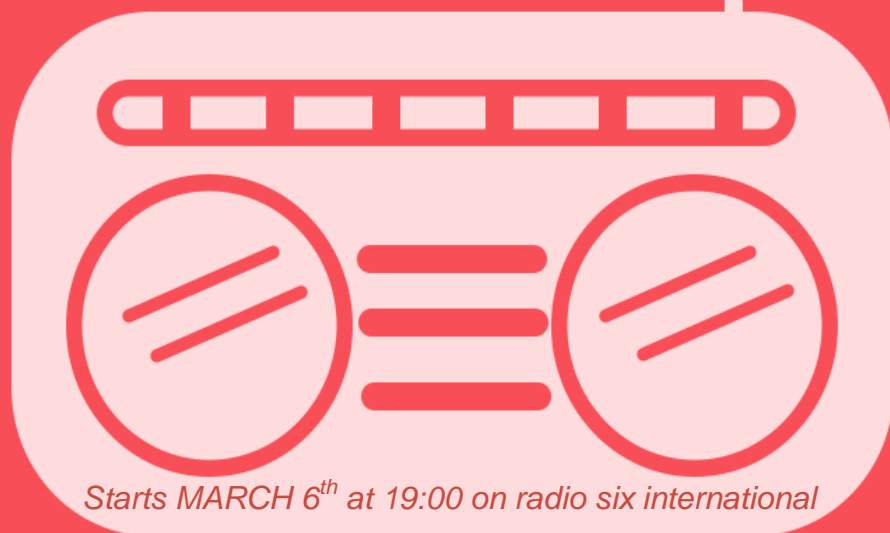

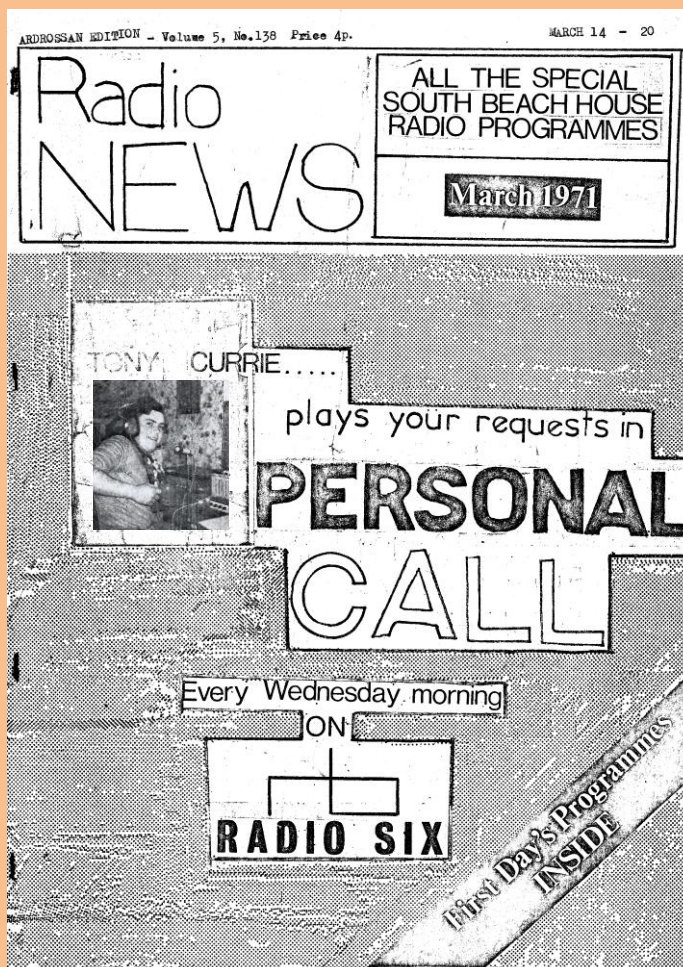

50 YEARS AGO



Negotiations with the Church of Scotland who owned and operated "South Beach House", the Eventide Home next door, were fruitful. It was agreed that Radio Six could provide a special weekly programme service to the residents. The programmes were piped to all the public rooms - Lounge, Dining Room, Ladies' Lounge and Gentlemen's Smoking Room. After some test transmissions, the service was launched at 11.15am on Wednesday 17th March 1971.

The Matron of the home, Mrs Hunter, conducted the Opening Ceremony and then it was straight into "Personal Call" with Tony Currie and Gordon Macdonald playing the residents' requests. Dave Marshall followed at 11.45 with quarter of an hour of light music, then Mac was back to "Pop Back The Clock".

"Time for Tony" at 12.15 featured special guest star Andy Stewart talking about his showbiz life, and then a final programme, "Faith in Focus" was our equivalent of the Epilogue, provided by Glasgow-based Gospel radio Fellowship. Well, it was a Church-owned home.

Thereafter, every Wednesday, the listeners had to hide in their bedrooms between 11am and 12.20pm if they wanted to avoid Radio Six. Few of them did, and most entered into the spirit, vying with each other to get their requests played in "Personal Call".
