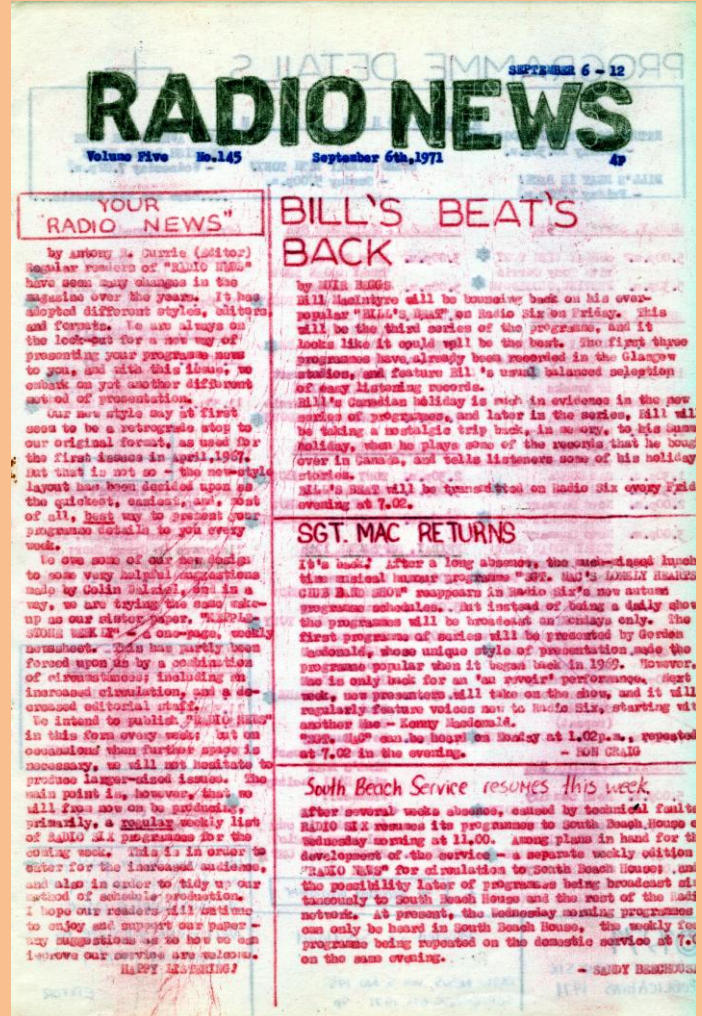

50 YEARS AGO



The autumn of 1971 brought a sudden switch back to the original two-page newsletter format that Radio News had begun with in 1967. As an attempt to ensure weekly publication, the new format was simple - editorial on the front and the programme schedules on the back. Several popular programmes made their return in the first week of September - "Bill's Beat" hosted by Bill MacIntyre (in reality Eric Simpson) with a third series heavily influenced by Eric's recent Canadian holiday. "Sgt Mac" also returned, this time with a new host, Kenny Macdonald, who became a familiar voice and face on BBC Scotland as special correspondent and sometime host of Newsnight Scotland. The South Beach House service resumed after a summer hiatus, and the daily "Teatime with Tony" reached its hundredth programme with a special edition broadcast live in front of an invited studio audience. "Saturday Sounds" was also back with Tony Currie in its usual late night slot.
