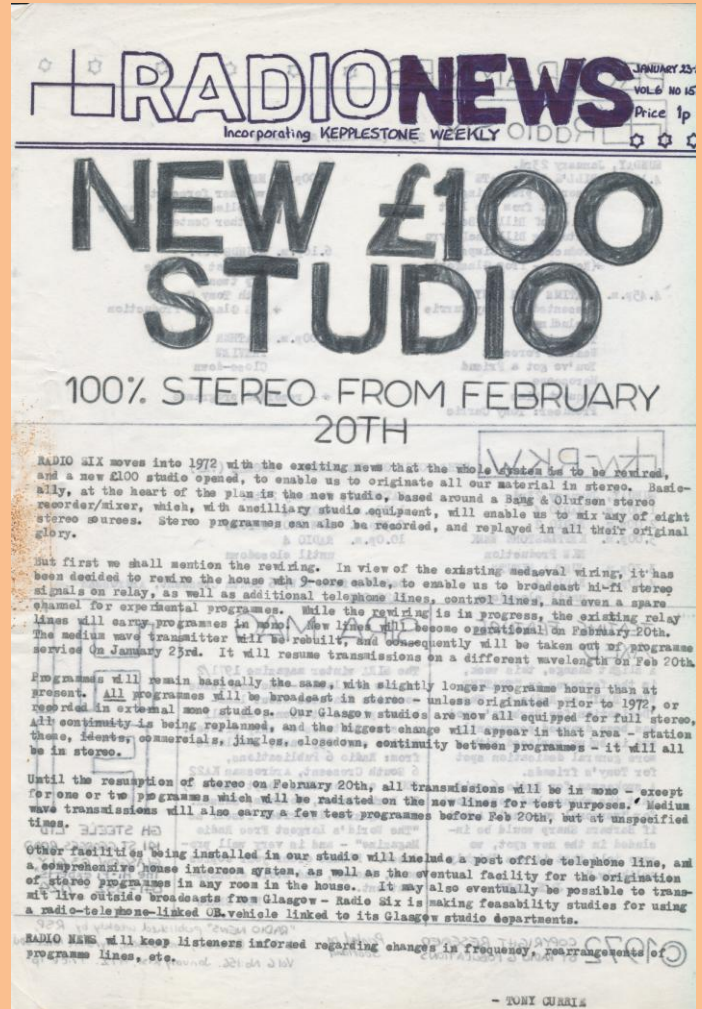

# 50 YEARS AGO



Add a three more zeroes to get the cost of today's studio, but in 1972 a hundred quid bought Radio Six something approaching state of the art in mixing and playback equipment. For the first time the station was using semi professional kit and that meant no more bodging stereo playback with crocodile clips and hope. To match this new technology, the whole house was to be rewired and turned into something rather better than the twisted together bits of old lighting flex that had seen service for nine years.

Programmes in January were, however, in short supply and consisted of a couple of hours on Sunday afternoon with reruns of "Bill's Beat", the usual "Teatime with Tony" and a chart show from HBS Glasgow. Tucked in a tiny corner of issue 156 was my news that "Teatime" would no longer include a weekly dedication for Barbara-Ann Sharp, a change which had come about for "personal reasons". Would she be included in a new general dedication slot, I asked? "Highly unlikely" I was told!!
