50 YEARS AGO



The big news 50 years ago was the official opening of Glasgow's hospital broadcasting service, HBS Glasgow. "Official" because the service had been on the air since December 1969! The 'opening' night programmes were hosted by Dave Jamieson, Alasdair Macmillan, Tony Currie, Eric Simpson, John Frame and Dave Marshall and although "Radio News" promised a list of guests stars, on the night Tony's live guests were Rikki Fulton and his wife Kate Matheson.

Fifty years on, HBS Glasgow is in healthy shape and continues to provide a much needed service to all the Glasgow hospitals.

Meanwhile back in May 1972 Radio Six continued apace – still only on Sundays but with a mix of programming from country dance show "Tarry Awhile" to the weekly mix of news and chat from "Aberdeen at Six-Fifteen" presented from the granite city by Colin Dalziel.
