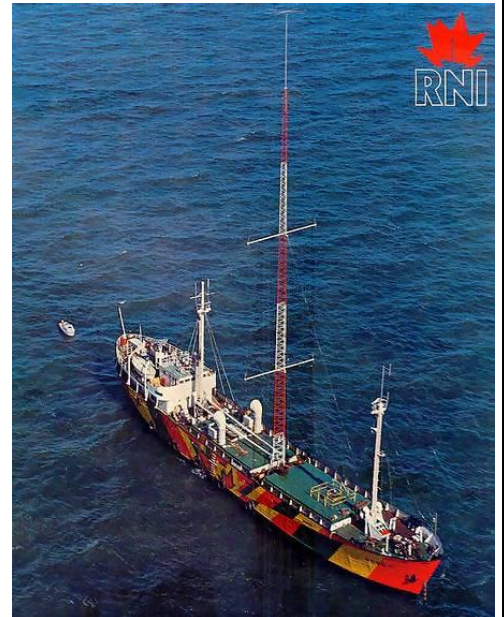

50 YEARS AGO



August 5th 1972. 8pm. The start of a non stop 52 hour broadcast from the Ardrossan studios. 34 people involved in the production of the programmes. One programme change – the man who always described himself as 'good old unreliable Steve' (*Steve Wright*) hadn't had time to make his Conservation documentary. And one very brief breakdown.

The August 26th issue thanked everyone concerned in enormous detail, and voted the broadcast 'a success' on its front page. Among those whose contributions were significant were Douglas Fulton (on-air name *Dougie Allan*) who not only hosted two editions of 'Vibrations' but also acted as station driver, ferrying broadcasters around Central Scotland. *Seymour Cottrell* at G.H. Steele in Glasgow, who loaned the station a mountain of bits of equipment from the shop's stock! *Dave Marshall* did an enormous pile of photocopying of Radio News, which was easy for him as he was a photocopier salesman at the time – his record-breaking stint as Radio Clyde breakfast host came 18 months later. And *Steve Wright* who did everything from reading the news to hosting Breakfast. A splendid team effort!
