CLOCKS ARE MOVING AGAIN...

As usual, Spring has crept up on us in the northern hemisphere, and with it the attendant changes to clock times. Radio Six International always gives its times in Greenwich Mean Time (GMT = the same as UTC) which means that from 26th March, for listeners in the UK, Europe and many other parts of the world, it will be necessary to add one hour to the times shown to get the clock time. Please note time changes only to Sunday evening programmes to keep those in step with UK and Europe times all year round.

In Australia and New Zealand, clocks go forward on 2nd April and from then we will again move the early morning transmission to 07:00 GMT. This will also affect Australian shortwave times which will mean Tuesday shortwave transmissions starting an hour later at 09:00 GMT. Details in our next issue.

23 YEARS AGO



Since early 1999, Radio Six had been again providing a minimal closed-circuit service to house and neighbours in Sherbrooke Avenue in Glasgow. But that all changed at 01:00 GMT on March 9th 2000 with the launch of Radio Six International - or Radio Six Online as it was originally named.

Initially the 'service' consisted of a four-hour loop of nonstop music, hosted by the late *Karin Spalter* and featuring a mix of current chart material and oldies. Radio News helpfully provided a complete playlist and the first record to be heard was The Beatles' "Day Tripper". *Tony Currie* wrote: "Soon we will add a selection of speech programmes and then more music, so that the repeat cycle becomes longer. Later we will experiment with live programming from the Glasgow studio."

The addition of speech programmes happened on July 25th, the name changed to Radio Six International with more fresh programming on 25th August 2001, and on Sunday 19th January 2002 at 17:20 GMT, programming was switched live to the Glasgow studio for "Random Play" with the completely live "Tony Currie Show" at 18:00.
