There has been a phenomenal response to the launch of our Medium Wave transmissions on 1467kHz from Roumoules in France, with over 250 emails received in the first few weeks. Many of these asked if we could bring the transmission forward by an hour, as with the clocks now set for summer time across Europe, Midnight in Lismore is 1am in Paris, and 2am in Athens. Listeners want to hear the show, not fall asleep waiting for it! We have listened to these requests, and so, from Saturday May 9th the broadcast will begin at 22:00 UTC on Saturday - that's 11pm in the UK, Midnight in most of Europe, and 1am in Finland and Greece. We hope this will please our new, and very eager listeners across the continent.

The main focus of this month's schedule is, of course, the Eurovision Song Contest which, at 70 years old, continues to provide controversy both artistic and political. Our team of pundits - the same people who brought you the much-lauded coverage of this year's Sanremo Song Festival - will be in the Austrian capital for the duration of the week-long event, and will report each evening on the latest developments.

Also of note this month are the National and Local elections in the UK. Both Scottish and Welsh voters are being asked to vote for a new parliament, and with a dramatic increase in the number of political parties, both large and small, the results become less predictable. Voters in parts of England will be electing local councils and, in some places, Mayors. We'll have coverage.

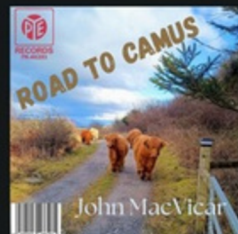
