There was a time when Radio Six International got awfully excited every year about its anniversary. Probably because, from year to year, it never quite knew who it would be broadcasting to (and how) twelve months' hence.

Certainly, the station has enjoyed many incarnations over the past 63 years. Schoolchildren's plaything...dedicated service for an old people's home...independent production company...experimental radio workshop...commercial cable radio network (the first in Europe)...pioneer internet broadcaster...shortwave broadcaster...and now the most powerful signal on Europe's AM medium wave band. Never a dull moment.

In previous years, day-long schedules of special programmes (indeed sometimes week-long) filled the pages of bumper editions of Radio News, but this year a quiet celebration as MIDNIGHT RENDEZVOUS gets an extra hour on June 6th and introduces our medium wave listeners to some other members of our team

From, July, there will be major changes to both the online programme schedule and the range of programmes. Some will end in June, including PLUGGIN BABY RADIO SHOW, AWESOME MIX and SCOTS RADIO. But from July, SOUNDWAVE, RECORD BOX, THE LIVELY LOUNGE, REVIVAL SHOW and EUROPE'S HEARTBEAT will all have their place on 1467kHz as programmes on that frequency are extended with an hour on Sunday between 2200 and 2300 UTC every week.
